“Over 1,000 people live on the streets of St. Louis City. These people may be homeless for different reasons, for example unemployment, mental illness, or poverty, but one thing they have in common is that when the sun goes down, they have no permanent home to call their own, and no guarantee they’ll find a place to sleep indoors....Peter & Paul Community Services offers a year round emergency shelter for homeless single adult men. The shelter provides beds, food, showers, laundry, lockers, and a safe, caring alternative to living on the street.”

Our commitment: We provide and serve a meal to 70 men who find themselves temporarily homeless. We bring fried chicken, side dishes, salad and dessert. We also like to play cards, chess or other games if time allows. This is a parent(adult)/child opportunity for 8th graders only as it takes place in the evening.
