*Please keep in mind that the Bridge now serves breakfast, lunch and dinner for 150-200 people each meal 7 days a week. They welcome leftovers from parties or large events to help feed those in need. Please call Angie Potter (314-302-5293) if you have food to donate.

Our commitment: We help prepare and serve a meal for dinner. Prep work takes place in the kitchen under the guidance of a Chef, we then help serve the meal from behind the counter. We also help in the clean up before heading home.

Who’s needed: 6-8 volunteers. Minimum 2 adults and 4-6 children or any combination of adults and children. Children must be in 6th grade or older.
