WHAT HAPPENS ON A CRHP WEEKEND?

The substance of the weekend is the presentation of personal stories in which your fellow parishioners share their faith with you. Group discussion and response are invited following each presentation. Opportunities for Scripture sharing, Reconciliation, and Eucharist are provided.

WHEN AND WHERE IS IT HELD?

Immacolata Parish will be hosting the Women’s Weekend January 28-29, 2012 at the Immacolata School.

WHO CONDUCTS THE WEEKEND?

The renewal team is comprised of a group of parishioners who have attended a previous weekend.

HOW LONG IS THE WEEKEND?

The weekend begins at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and concludes by 4:30 p.m. on Sunday.

WHO MAY ATTEND?

Any adult parishioner, 18 or older, or a non-Catholic that lives within the parish boundary is eligible to attend a CRHP weekend.

IS THERE A COST?

A voluntary donation may be made at the end of retreat.
